- The Thurmond Lake level started the month of April off at 330.71 feet and ended at 330.35 feet.
- The new water treatment plant is operational. We have continued to run the new plant and now have it dialed in to producing high quality drinking water. Lindsey Bounds with SCDHEC will be on site Wednesday, May 18th to inspect the new plant and hopefully grant us our permit to operate.
- We have received our Certificate of Occupancy from the county.
- Pipe has been run to the new tank on Hwy 221. It should not be too much longer before we can start filling it, test it, and put it in operation.
- Hydrant flushing and flow testing began on Tuesday, May 10th and will continue throughout this week and most likely into next week.
- Overall, operations are running smoothly.

<u>Cheryl Daniels ~ General Manager:</u>

- The water plant is progressing on schedule. DHEC is scheduled to come for certification of the new plant on May 18.
- Open house for the new water plant is scheduled for Wednesday, June 29. The time will be from 1:00 to 3:00 pm.
- We have purchased a Kubota mini excavator with jackhammer and bushhog from Carolina Power Equipment in Greenwood. These items have been in the 5-year capital plan for several years and JR was able to locate them at this local dealership. The excavator is in stock and other items should be received in a couple of weeks.
- JR, Kevin Ashley and I are attending the ElectriCities Safety & Training Kickoff Wednesday May 11 in Columbia.
- We have advertised for a wastewater operator or trainee. Ralph Parks is retiring at the end of the year.
